# Big Buck




**S**ince 1956, when the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and Illinois Natural History Survey began conducting surveys of Illinois hunters, trappers and residents, many things have been learned about what white-tailed deer mean to the people of Illinois.

We know residents enjoy watching Illinois' state animal and largest mammal near their homes, in rural areas and in state parks. Hunters enjoy the pursuit of white-tailed deer and the sustenance their meat provides to family and friends. Information like this, gathered through user-group surveys, allows state biologists to account for the expectations Illinoisans have to observe, hunt and interact with deer when herd management decisions are made.

Whereas most deer hunters cite their desire to spend time outdoors as motivation for hunting deer in Illinois, many hunters also report hunting deer to provide meat for their families and to socialize with their family and friends. A considerable number of Illinois deer hunters are motivated by the chance to harvest a trophy buck, and this issue of *Outdoor-Illinois* provides the chance to recognize hunters who fulfilled that dream. Congratulations to everyone who got out there to enjoy Illinois's natural resources last fall, and especially to the following hunters who submitted records to the Big Buck Recognition Program in 2006.

The Big Buck Recognition Program honors deer hunters annually. Qualifying deer taken by firearm and archery hunters are scored by certified measurers after 60 days of drying, with standards set by the Boone and Crockett Club. To qualify, deer taken by firearm must have a minimum score of 140 for a typical rack and 160 for a non-typical rack. For archery and crossbow hunters, the minimum score is 115 for typical and 130 for non-typical antlers.
