STATEWIDE PERMIT NO. 3

AUTHORIZING MOORING FACILITIES USED  
EXCLUSIVELY FOR BARGE FLEETING PURPOSES

**PURPOSE**

Permission is hereby granted for the construction of deadmen, pier cells, and other similar mooring facilities, which are to be used solely for the purpose of barge fleeting. This permit does not authorize the construction of such devices for barge docking or loading/unloading facilities nor does it authorize dredging or other associated construction. It is not necessary to submit applications for permit to, or obtain individual permits from, the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources, for mooring facilities meeting the specified terms and conditions.

**APPLICABILITY**

This permit is applicable to all rivers, lakes and streams of the State within the jurisdiction of the Department except those in Lake, McHenry, Cook, DuPage, Kane and Will Counties for which regulatory floodways have been designated pursuant to 17 Illinois Administrative Code 3708.

**SPECIAL CONDITION**

This permit is valid only when the deadmen, pier cells, or other similar anchorage devices have been permitted by the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- (a) This permit is granted in accordance with the Rivers, Lakes and Streams Act, 615 ILCS 5 (1996 State Bar Edition).
- (b) This permit does not convey or recognize any title of the Permittee to any submerged or other lands, and further more, does not convey, lease or provide any right or rights of occupancy or use of the public or private property on which the project or any part thereof will be located, or otherwise grant to any permittee any right or interest in or to the property whether the property is owned or possessed by the State of Illinois or by any private or public party or parties.

- (c) This permit does not release the permittee from liability for damage to persons or property resulting from any activity covered by this permit and does not sanction any injury to private property or invasion of private rights, or infringement of any federal, state or local laws or regulations.
- (d) This permit shall remain in effect until such time as it is modified, suspended, or revoked by the Department of Natural Resources.

This Statewide Permit was issued on October 27, 1981 and last modified or corrected June 15, 1998.
