ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from December 15 to January 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All of these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1604940 - This project involves water diversion repairs at 22 locations on existing trails at Pere Marquette SP. Project was submitted for review on 11-16-15.

- **Illinois Beach State Park**

1604290 - This project involves placement of approximately 20 interpretive displays and trail signs for Illinois Beach SP. Project was submitted for review on 10-20-15.

- **North Point Marina**

1604518 - This project involves placement of 8 guide signs at North Point Marina. Project was submitted for review on 12-8-15.

- **Gillespie State Natural Area**

1605409 - This project involves installation of a 30" diameter pipeline. The pipeline will be placed under the SNA by directional boring. Project was submitted for review on 10-16-15.

- **Clinton Lake State Recreation Area**

1603343 - This project involves correcting drainage issues at the Handicap Wetland. Project was submitted for review on 9-17-15.

- **Redwing Slough State Natural Area**

1603972 - This project involves demolition and removal of two deteriorated buildings. Project was submitted for review on 10-7-15.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

1410890 - This project involves construction of a new dog park. The off-leash area will be comprised of two fenced enclosures approximately ½ acre each. Site amenities will include the area bounded by a 4-foot tall fence and post with maintenance access gates, public access gates, concreted sidewalks, and one yard hydrant. Project was submitted for review on 4-30-14.

- **Giant City State Park**

1606192 - This project involves improvements to the grounds in the immediate vicinity of Giant City Lodge. Project was submitted for review on 1-8-16.

- **Vesely Prairie Unit**

1606241 - This project involves drain tile surveys and modifications to stabilize the Unit's hydrology. Project was submitted for review on 1-12-16.

- **Des Plaines State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1605239 - This project involves replacing or repairing roofs on four buildings. Project was submitted for review on 11-25-15.
