ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from March 15 to April 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All of these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Delebar State Park**

1809612 - This project involves upgrading the electric service. The project will install new power poles, replace wire, and switch gear. Project was submitted for review on 4-4-18.

- **Des Plaines State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1809330 - This project involves fuel reduction removal on approximately 75 acres. Project was submitted for review on 3-27-18.

- **I&M Canal**

1808804 - This project involves safety repairs to the timber and steel bridge which provides access to the Johns Manville facility in Rockdale. Project was submitted for review on 3-16-18.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1809461 - This project involves the chimney/roof repairs necessary on cabins to correct water leakage. Project was submitted for review on 3-30-18.

- **Cypress Pond State Natural Area**

1809249 - This project involves enhancing the habitat of the area by buffering the transition between upland and forested areas. Project was submitted for review on 3-27-18.

- **Vandalia State House**

1805513 - This project involves window repairs, replacing fencing, painting, and removing a decaying tree. Project was submitted for review on 1-4-18.

- **Marseilles State Fish & Wildlife Area**

1809157- This project involves a variety of resource restoration or improvement projects to satisfy the IL National Guard Training Center. Projects include: dredge 3 small ponds, clear brush to reveal hazards, install a gravel pad firing point, clearing of invasive species, etc. Project was submitted for review on 3-26-18.

- **Illinois Beach State Park**

1806109 - This project involves repairs to the main parking lot which was damaged from high wave action in 2017. Project was submitted for review on 1-16-18.

- **Johnson-Sauk Trail State Park**

1807830 - This project involves replacing the roof on the Round Barn. Project was submitted for review on 2-14-18.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1808574 - This project involves replacing the Equestrian Concession pedestrian bridge. Project was submitted for review on 3-8-18.

- **Pere Marquette State Park**

1808806 - This project involves repairs to the electric service at the Class A Campground. Project was submitted for review on 3-16-18.

- **Fox Ridge State Park**

1809096 - This project involves grading the road shoulders to provide proper drainage. Project was submitted for review on 3-23-18.

- **Gillespie Prairie State Natural Area**

1803940 - This project involves maintenance to underground pipeline. Project was submitted for review on 11-8-17.

- **Kickapoo State Park**

1809097 - This project involves constructing a Chimney

Swift nesting tower. Project was submitted for review on 3-23-18.

- **Dana Thomas State Historic Site**

1809141 - This project involves constructing new parking facilities. Project was submitted for review on 3-26-18.

- **Lincoln's New Salem State Historic Site**

1807270 - This project involves replacing the roof on four structures. Project was submitted for review on 2-8-18.

- **I&M Canal**

1808704 - This project involves trail repairs on the I&M Canal near McKinley Woods. Project was submitted for review on 3-13-18.

- **Rock Island State Trail**

1808688 - This project involves replacement of the ADA entrance ramp leading into the historic Depot. Project was submitted for review on 2-16-18.

- **Rock Cut State Park**

1808689 - This project involves replacing the roof on the shower building. Project was submitted for review on 3-13-18.

- **Big River State Forest**

1808687 - This project involves replacing the roof on the maintenance building. Project was submitted for review on 3-13-18.

- **Eldon Hazlet State Park**

1808640 - This project involves replacing the roof on six buildings. Project was submitted for review on 3-9-18.
