ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS COMPLETED

Project reviews completed from June 15 to July 15 are listed below. These projects have been screened through the internal environmental review process for potential impacts on wetlands, threatened and endangered species, and cultural and archaeological resources, etc. Through the review process it was determined that environmental impacts have been kept to a minimum and mitigated as necessary, that they do not meet the criteria for significant actions as defined in the environmental review process, and may proceed. All of these projects are in compliance with the Endangered Species Protection Act, Natural Areas Preservation Act, Interagency Wetlands Policy Act and cultural resource statutes.

- **Silver Springs State Park**

0904533 - This project involves the removal of the Millhurst Structure which is adjacent to Silver Springs State Park. Abutment walls for a gate structure that was never completed will be removed. Removal of concrete wall at center island. Broken concrete will be used to stabilize channel banks. Project was submitted for review on 12-16-08.

- **Clinton Lake State Recreation Area**

0911762 - This project will stabilize concrete slabs by adding rock to the sides and ends of all five existing boat access ramps at Clinton Lake SRA. Project was submitted for review on 6-15-09.

- **Kickapoo State Park**

0911799 - This project will stabilize concrete slabs by adding rock to the sides and ends of all existing boat access ramps at Kickapoo SP. In addition, sand will be re-graded at the canoe launch, and river rock and fabric placed to provide a more stable approach to the river. Project was submitted for review on 6-16-09.

- **Rall Woods State Natural Area**

0910976 - This project involves the construction of a new parking lot along S. Airhart Road. Project was submitted for review on 5-27-09.

- **Mackinaw State Fish & Wildlife Area**

0911580 - This project involves the repair of levee to original conditions. A shallow water wetland will be created in borrow area. Project was submitted for review on 6-4-09.

- **Conservation World**

1000117 - This project involves installing permeable surfaces in Conservation World to raise awareness of nonpoint source pollution problems associated with stormwater runoff. Project was submitted for review on 6-26-09.

- **Rock Island State Trail**

0910972 - This project involves installing a 8" - 12" culvert to drain an area that is retaining runoff water. Project was submitted for review on 5-26-09.
