PUBLIC NOTICE

Construction of a floating dock In the North Branch of the Chicago River in the City of Chicago

Ari Golan, 1501 N. Magnolia Avenue, Chicago, IL 60642 has applied for an after the fact Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources' (IDNR/OWR) permit to construct a floating dock in the North Branch of the Chicago River. The proposed work took place on the southwest bank of the North Branch of the Chicago River in the North Avenue Turning Basin south of North Avenue in the City of Chicago.

The applicant has constructed a shore attached floating dock consisting of a 20 ft. long by 3.5 ft. wide aluminum ramp, a 20 ft. long by 7 ft. wide mid-section and a 40 ft. long by 8 ft. wide main dock section. A location map and plans are attached to this notice.


