Every coroner or medical examiner shall on or before the tenth of each month report in writing to the Department the circumstances surrounding the death of any person that has occurred as a result of a boating accident within the examiner's jurisdiction during the preceding calendar month. This action is mandated by 625 ILCS 45/6-1 E(1) E(2).
