**Private Land Waterfowl Hunting**  
**Illinois Recreational Access Program – IRAP**  
**Information and Application Instructions**

The Private Land WATERFOWL Hunts will take place on private property leased by IDNR from **November 1-December 31**. Access has been provided through the cooperation of landowners and the IL Dept. of Natural Resources. Each site is capable of holding up to 4 hunters in a group.

Participating in this program is a special privilege. Please be respectful, ethical, and safe hunters.

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**ELIGIBILITY and Rules\***

- All hunters must possess a valid hunting permit, a hunting license, Firearms Owners Identification Card (FOID) card. A youth hunter without a FOID card may hunt with an adult who has a valid FOID card.
- If born in 1980 or after, the hunter must have completed a Department-approved Hunter Education Course.
- A youth hunter may have a non-hunting adult (mentor) accompany them throughout the entire hunting experience. The mentor cannot hunt or carry a firearm and if the mentor is not a parent or legal guardian, then they must fill out attachment C.
- Each hunter must complete an application, liability form and send to the address below. If requesting to hunt as a group, all applications must be sent in together.

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**APPLICATION PROCESS\***

- A hunter may submit more than one application, each for a different IRAP waterfowl hunting season and/or site. Applicants will be put in a drawing for each site during each hunting period. Once an applicant is awarded a site, then their chances lessen as new hunters will be given precedent that have not hunted on IRAP leased property this waterfowl season. However, waterfowl applicants are not limited to the number of times they apply or hunt.
- Each site can accommodate up to four hunters. If you are applying as a group, you must turn all your paperwork in together.
- Legibly provide all of the information requested on the application, liability waiver (attachment B) and the Adult authorization form (Attachment C, if applicable)
- The completed **Application** (Attachment A), **Release and Waiver of Liability** (Attachment B), and **Parent Authorization Form** (Attachment C, if applicable), must be received by 5 p.m. via email, mail, fax or hand delivery at least 21 days before the time period you are applying for.
- Hunters will be assigned a hunting area on private land. They will be provided a map and site permit that allows the hunter special access to their assigned hunting site. The site will be marked with a sign for parking.
- Each hunter or group of hunters will have a 5 day period to hunt the site. Access to the site is **ONLY** during the assigned hunting period.
- For 2019 hunting only **MACOUPIN and MONTGOMERY counties** have waterfowl site with furnished 4-man blinds.

**Other Important Information\***

- The hunter/group is expected to adhere to all Federal, State and local laws and regulations, including those laws and regulations referenced in the most recent Illinois Digest of Hunting and Trapping Regulations and Waterfowl Hunting Regulations; be prepared with appropriate clothing, gear, firearm, etc.; and have necessary valid permits and licenses available for inspection while hunting.
- IRAP staff will hold a lottery, if necessary, for specific sites, approx. 20 days prior to the first day of the specific IRAP hunting period.
- Dogs and decoys allowed.
- No boats. Walk in access only
- Only those successful applicants will be notified by mail or e-mail.
- You must leave the site as you found it. Please pick up all trash, shotgun shells and other materials you brought with you.

*\*Failure to comply with eligibility and rules will result in denial of hunting privileges on IRAP leased property*

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**Firearms Safety - All IRAP Waterfowl hunters born in 1980 after must have completed firearm safety training before the day of the hunt.**

## **RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNER, IDNR, AND STATE OF ILLINOIS**

I agree that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of the Risk and Indemnification agreement ("Release") is intended to be broad and inclusive and includes, but is not limited to, the following terms and conditions:

1. *Landowner.* For purposes of this Release, "Landowner" shall include the possessor of any interest in real property participating in IRAP, whether it be a tenant, lessee, occupant, or person in control of the premises.
2. *Real Property.* For the purposes of this Release, "Real Property" or "Property" shall include roads, water, watercourses, private ways and buildings, structures, and machinery or equipment when attached to the realty.
3. *No Violation of Laws and Regulations.* I agree and covenant that I will abide by all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. I have read and understand the rules and regulations referenced in the Information and Application Instructions.
4. *Release of Liability, Assumption of the Risk, and Indemnity.*
  - A. By entering upon and remaining on the Property, I accept the Property and any improvements in an "as is" condition.
  - B. I agree that no warranty has been made by Landowner, IDNR, or the State of Illinois, as to the condition of the Property. I understand that dangerous conditions can and do exist on the Property. I acknowledge and affirm that I am aware of the damage, injury or death that I and any others with me may encounter.
  - C. I hereby acknowledge and release Landowner, IDNR, and the State of Illinois, from all responsibility and liability for any dangers, accidents, damage to property, injuries to self or others, death, risks and hazards associated with my entry upon, presence on, and/or use of the Property and I assume and accept all responsibility and liability for the same.
  - D. To the fullest extent permitted by law, I do hereby agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Landowner, IDNR, and the State of Illinois from and against any and all causes of action, liability, claims, demands, losses, damages, injuries to or death of any person or persons, and costs of every type (including attorneys' fees and legal costs) associated with or resulting from my entry upon, presence on, and/or use of the Property, even if the sole negligence of Landowner, IDNR, or the State of Illinois, is the cause of such liability, claim, demand, loss, cause of action, accident, injury, death or damages.
5. *All Participants Must Sign a Release.* I agree to have no other person with me during my time on the Property who has not signed an identical Release of liability and is not a registered IRAP Participant.
