Illinois Conservation Laws: Protecting the Public and Our Natural Resources

Recommendations:

- 1. Increase staffing levels of uniformed Conservation Police Officers (CPOs) based on current needs analysis.
- 2. CPO's enforcement duties should be prioritized as follows (breakout session results):
 - 1. Public safety (boating, snowmobile, park enforcement)
 - 2. Invasive species (Asian Carp, illegal transportation of fish/aquatic life)
 - 3. Sport Fishing (licensing, creel, size limits etc.)
 - 4. Hunting (wildlife enforcement/trapping)
 - 5. Commercial (licensing, taxidermy, fur buyers, fish, outfitters, timber buyers etc.)
- 3. Create a CPO-dedicated investigative unit to handle complex and undercover investigations.
- 4. A potential CPO-dedicated investigative unit's priority should be (breakout session results):
 - 1. Fish/Wildlife Investigations
 - 2. Environmental crimes (pollution, chemical spills)
 - 3. Commercial Investigations
 - 4. Internal Investigations
- 5. Create statutory authority for CPOs to conduct criminal records inquiries on potential employees and volunteers who work with minors, vulnerable adults.
