Project Description:

This project proposes to construct a temporary aggregate road to a leaking gas line in section 23, township 6 South, range 8 West. Beginning at the levee the road will be 12 feet wide and extend approx. 600 feet west then turn south to the waters edge an additional 100 feet, beyond the water edge the road will extend an additional 200 feet. At the lead location an earthen berm/dyke approx 100 feet in circumference will be constructed. it is possible that a number of overstory trees will likely be impacted and may necessitate removal.

Upon construction completion the contractor shall remove all access elements including the aggregate road, and earthen berm/dyke in the waterway.

All disturbed areas to be seed, fertilized and mulched. Mitigation plans are being developed to address resource damages.
