 Project Description:

This project will construct a new interpretive trailhead facility to orient users to the adjacent Wise Ridge/Bedrock Hill SNA. The trailhead will consist of a three-sided kiosk structure, bike rack, bench or table, trash receptacle and associated concrete sidewalks. All of the trailhead facility will be built on the ROW of the Tunnel Hill State Trail, immediately abutting the bike trail which bisects the southwest part of Wise Ridge. The total area to be impacted by the trailhead project will be an area approximately 25' x 65'. The vegetation to be impacted will be minimal and no tree removal over 6" dbh is needed.

Wise Ridge was purchased using federal Land and Water Conservation Funds. Development of the trailhead fulfills part of the grant agreement with the use of these funds.
