**Project Description:**

This project proposes two alternatives within the same work area foot print.

The existing lake/pond is spring fed with a constant flow of water estimated at 5 to 10 gpm.

This project proposes to capture the spring run-off and using either a surface swale flowline or alternatively, excavate a trench and bury a 6" +/- dia. perforated drain tile 12" to 18" deep. The terminal point for both alternatives is at an existing surface drainage inlet located on the adjacent property owner. The project scope of work would include at a minimum minor surface grading to create the swale flow line and reseed. The alternate would require trench excavation, pipe laying, trench backfill, final grading and reseeding.
