


Lockport Gallery

The Gallery is located on the first floor of a massive limestone structure built around 1850 as a grain-processing center. Today, past and present come together in light, spacious galleries that showcase Illinois art. Located in the heart of the I & M Canal National Heritage Corridor, the Lockport Gallery is a popular destination and a convenient docking point for access to other local attractions.






Location
