Rules and Information

This shoot is registered with the NSSA. All events will be conducted in accordance with current NSSA and ISSA regulations.

Licensed NSSA referees will be in charge on the field and their decisions will be final. Any appeals must be filed with the Chief Referee in accordance with NSSA protest rules.

Management reserves the right to alter or suspend the program if it deems conditions warrant and also reserves the right to refuse entry or cause the withdrawal of any shooter for any reason the management deems

appropriate. These rights are reserved without recourse or protest.

Class AAA will be offered if there are at least 12 entries in the event.

Ties for Champion, Runner Up, and Third in all main events and class places will be decided by shoot offs. All shoot- offs will be doubles from station 3,4, & 5, miss and out by station. Concurrents to be determined by long run.

It is the participant's responsibility to have their classification card up to date before presenting it at the registration desk. Shooters are required to register at least thirty minutes prior to their flight time. Each squad will appear at a designated field no later than when the previous squad begins to shoot its last pair.

Participants will not be allowed to pick up shells from the grounds during or after the shoot. Ammunition will be on sale at the club. Shooters are responsible for providing all proof and shoot- off shells. Reloads are per-mitted in all events and shoot- offs.

Spectators and contestants assume all risks, responsibility, and liability resulting from accident or loss/ theft of property occurring on the club grounds. No alcoholic beverages will be consumed until the shooter has completed shooting for the day. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times.

Practice is available at \$5.00 per 25 targets. Practice fields open from 10 a.m.– 6 p.m. on Friday and 7:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Four gun shooters have priority on shooting times and rotations.
