



Rules and Information

This shoot is registered with the NSSA. All events will be conducted in accordance with current NSSA and ISSA regulations.

Licensed NSSA referees will be in charge on the field and their decisions will be final. Any appeals must be filed with the Chief Referee in accordance with NSSA Protest Rules.

Management reserves the right to alter or suspend the program if it deems conditions warrant and also reserves the right to refuse entry or cause the withdrawal of any shooter for any reason the management deems appropriate. These rights are reserved without recourse or protest.


Class AAA will be offered if there are at least 100 total entries in the event.

Ties for Champion, Runner-up, and Third in all Main events, Class Places and Concurrents will be decided by shoot-offs. All shoot-offs will be doubles from stations 3, 4, & 5, miss and out by station.

It is the participant's responsibility to have their classification card up-to-date before presenting it at the registration desk. Shooters are required to register at least thirty minutes prior to their flight time. Each squad will appear at the designated field no later than when the previous squad begins to shoot its last pair of doubles.

Participants will not be allowed to pick up shells from the grounds during or after the shoot. Ammunition will be on-sale at the club. Management will provide proof shells. Shooters are responsible for providing all shoot-off shells. Reloads are permitted in all events and shoot-offs.

Spectators and contestants assume all risks, responsibility, and liability resulting from accident or loss/theft of property occurring on the club grounds. No alcoholic beverages will be consumed until the shooter has completed shooting for the day. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.




General Information

- Registration opens at 10 AM on Friday and at 7:30 AM Saturday and Sunday
- 1000 Camping sites are available, contact the WSRC for reservations.
- Practice is available at \$5.00 per round. Practice fields open at 7:30 AM on Saturday and Sunday
- Shooting order: 12/Doubles Friday, 12/28 Saturday, 20/.410 Sunday
- Four Gun Shooters have priority on shooting times and rotations.
- All Concurrent Events Offered at No-Charge (Honors Only)
- Those wishing to squad together send registration forms together along with \$50.00 per shooter, indicate shooting order and rotation preference
- HOA and HAA Class Determined by NSSA Recommended Class Table Refer to Page 50 of NSSA Rule Book
- Fees: The ISSA requires \$2.00 for each 100 targets shot, the NSSA requires \$3.00 for each 100 shot. This fee is in addition to the event entry fee excluding HOA/HAA
- All Concurrent Events are offered at no charge (Honors Only) ties will be determined by shoot-off concurrent with other events if possible
- Fees for Sub-Jr, Jr, and Collegiate Shooters is \$33.00 plus fees in main gauge events and therefore not eligible for purses unless they pay full event fee at time of registration.


One class for every 10 entries. High Gun System

Three classes based on two man average, see table for detail. Four teams or less, 100% to Champ. More than four teams, Champ & Runner-up team split 60/40%. Teams not required to be on same squad. Ties shoot-off.

Concurrent Events (per gun and HOA) \$ NC

LY, SJ, JR, TS, SU, SS, SR, VT, SV, CL, RM, ML, HW, PC.

Optional Class Purse Events 1—7 \$10.00

Each Gun Champ - \$250 Runner-up - \$150 3rd - \$100

Doubles CH and RU Only - \$175/\$125

HOA Champ - \$500 Runner-up - \$300 3rd - \$200

Class HOA - \$3,100

Divided based on class participation

Example: If there are 150 HOA entries and 20 of those entries are AA shooters this class will receive 13% of the added money divided based upon the payout table on page 9.

Mandatory Purse

Each individual gun event fee has \$10.00 of mandatory purse. Sub-Jr, Jr, and Collegiate shooters are exempt from mandatory purse but can opt to waive this exemption. 100% of all mandatory purses are returned to the shooters.

- Keeps you fundamentally solid
- Develop a strong mental game
